



**Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF II) Final Reporting  
Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021  
January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

In compliance with Section 314(e) of Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) the following is American Institute of Beauty, Inc.'s fourth quarter 2021 Initial and Final Report describing the use of funds distributed from the U.S. Department of Education.

1. American Institute of Beauty, Inc. signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certificate and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. Because American Institute of Beauty, Inc. has elected to decline the CRRSAA grant money, to return that grant money in its entirety to the Department of Education and to not provide grants to students, the Certificate and Agreement is no longer applicable.
2. The total amount of funds that American Institute of Beauty, Inc. has received from the Department of Education pursuant to the Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$339,730.00. American Institute of Beauty, Inc. has elected to decline receipt of those funds, is in the process of returning those funds in their entirety to the Department of Education and will not be using those funds to provide grants to students.
3. As of today, January 10, 2022, the total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$0.00. American Institute of Beauty, Inc. has elected to decline receipt of that grant money, is in the process of returning that grant money in its entirety to the Department of Education and will not be providing grants to students.
4. The estimated total number of students at American Institute of Beauty, Inc. eligible to participate in programs under CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) is: 0 students. No Emergency Financial Aid Grants will be provided to students; the entire amount of the grant, \$339,730, has been declined by American Institute of Beauty, Inc. And is in the process of being returned to the Department of Education.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under CRRSAA and ARP(a)(1) and (a)(4) is: 0 students. No Emergency Financial Aid Grants will be provided to students; the grant funds are being returned, in full, to the Department of Education.
